


# iMovie: Features

Clips Viewer: add and arrange clips, seeing the clip name and preview.

Rewind to the beginning of your movie.


Play movie full screen.

Timeline Viewer: add and arrange clips, seeing the time of clip, and 2 audio tracks.

Switch between importing video and editing clips.

Adjust the volume of iMovie.
